<u>2-day Show</u>: Shows will operate as 2 individual shows, with a day high point for each show, and a combined high point for both shows together. Exhibitors must compete in both shows to be considered for 2-day high point.

<u>T-Shirt Show</u>: may show in the current OkHSA t-shirt, along with required apparel (boots, hat/helmet, etc.)

Exhibitors select their division based on an honor system regarding their riding experience level (not the horse's ability):

*W/T - an exhibitor who does not have the ability to show at the lope

*Novice - an exhibitor who has just begun to show at the lope; not a

seasoned/accomplished exhibitor

*Open W/T – classes open to any and everyone for practice/warm up. These classes do not count towards any high point or year end awards.

***Évery exhibitor must fill out a registration form, designating their division.
